TO BE LEGALLY BINDING YOU MUST SIGN YOUR WILL AND HAVE IT WITNESSED IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER

1. BEFORE SIGNING

- 1.1. Read through your Will carefully
- 1.2. Make sure it reflects your instructions and intentions exactly
- 1.3. Date your Will the day that you sign it

2. YOUR WITNESSES:-

- 2.1. You **must** have two witnesses
- 2.2. Your witnesses must **not** be blood relatives **nor** anyone mentioned in your Will **nor** their partner
- 2.3. They must be over 18 years of age
- 2.4. They should **not** be blind
- 2.5. They **must** be of sound mind

3. ATTESTATION (Signing)

4. You **must** sign your Will in the presence of both witnesses together, who should both see you sign
5. Both witnesses **must** then sign in your presence, adding their name, address and occupation in the space provided
6. Your witnesses do not need to know the contents of your Will.
